EASTER EGG COOKIES

THESE ARE AN EASY AND TASTY WAY TO USE UP THAT EASTER CHOCOLATE!

INGREDIENTS

250G PLAIN FLOUR

1/2 TSP BAKING SODA

1/4 TSP SALT

170G UNSALTED BUTTER (MELTED)

200G LIGHT BROWN SUGAR

100G CASTER SUGAR
1 TBS VANILLA EXTRACT
1 X EGG
1 X EASTER EGG (ANY EASTER CHOCOLATE
CHOPPED SMALL WILL WORK)

MAKES 20 BUT MIXTURE CAN ALSO BE FROZEN FOR LATER

METHOD



- 1. PREHEAT OVEN TO 170 DEGREES
- 2.IN A MEDIUM BOWL POUR IN FLOUR, BAKING SODA AND SALT.
- 3.IN A LARGE BOWL CREAM TOGETHER THE MELTED BUTTER AND SUGAR THEN ADD IN THE VANILLA AND EGG.
- 4. ROUGHLY CHOP UP THE EASTER EGGS/TREATS TO MAKE LITTLE CHOCOLATE CHIPS.
- 5. ADD IN THE FLOUR MIX AND CHOPPED CHOCOLATE AND MIX UNTIL JUST BLENDED TOGETHER.
- 6. ROLL BALLS AROUND THE SIZE OF GOLF BALLS AND PLACE ONTO A GREASED BAKING TRAY LEAVING AROUND 8-10 CM GAP IN BETWEEN EACH COOKIE AND DO NOT FLATTEN MIXTURE.
- 7.BAKE FOR 10-12 MINS. THE EDGES SHOULD JUST SLIGHTLY BE TOASTED
- 8. LEAVE TO COOL AND HARDEN THEN ENJOY!

FOOD WASTE WARRIORS

REGROW SPRING ONIONS!

THIS IS A FUN WAY TO PREVENT FOOD WASTE AND TO DISCOVER HOW TO EASILY REGROW VEGGIES - IT'S SUPER QUICK TOO!



AFTER EATING THE SPRING ONIONS SAVE THE ENDS OF THE BULBS LEAVING ROOTS ATTACHED.

STAND THE BULBS ROOT-END DOWN IN A SMALL JAR.

ADD ENOUGH WATER TO COVER THE ROOTS, BUT LEAVE THE TOP EDGES ABOVE WATER.





SET ON A WINDOWSILL AND KEEP THE ROOTS MOIST. AFTER A FEW DAYS, GREEN SHOOTS WILL EMERGE FROM THE TOPS OF THE BULBS. AFTER THAT, THEY'LL GROW VERY QUICKLY!

KEEP THE ROOTS SUBMERGED AND CHANGE WATER AT LEAST ONCE A WEEK.

WHEN THE SHOOTS ARE OR FOUR OR FIVE INCHES LONG, YOU CAN PLANT THEM IN THE GROUND OR A POT FILLED WITH GOOD QUALITY POTTING SOIL.

REPOTTING IS IMPORTANT TO KEEP THE ONIONS STRONG SO THEY CAN KEEP REPRODUCING.

GROWN UPS CAN CUT OFF WHAT THEY NEED, CUTTING THE LEAVES ALL THE WAY TO THE GROUND: THE ONIONS WILL CONTINUE TO GROW AGAIN FROM THE CUT END!

BIRD CAKE FEEDER

THIS IS GREAT FOR THOSE LITTLE LEFTOVERS AND DON'T WORRY, NO BAKING IS REQUIRED!



METHOD

COMBINE YOUR CHOSEN INGREDIENTS IN A BOWL AND ADD SOFTENED LARD OR DRIPPING MIX TOGETHER INTO A FIRM PASTE. FOR BEST RESULTS YOU'LL NEED TO GET YOUR HANDS IN THERE! THIS A GREAT ACTIVITY FOR KIDS, IF A BIT MESSY! PIERCE THE BOTTOM OF A CLEAN YOGHURT POT AND POKE A LENGTH OF STRING THROUGH KNOT SECURELY ON THE INSIDE OF THE POT SO THAT IT HANGS UPSIDE DOWN LIKE A BELL FILL WITH THE FAT MIXTURE AND HANG OUTSIDE.

THIS FEEDER IS MOST SUITABLE FOR THE COOLER MONTHS OF SPRING AS FAT CAN BECOME RANCID IN HOT TEMPERATURES. IF THE WEATHER DOES BECOME HOTTER THE FEEDER CAN BE WRAPPED AND PLACED IN THE FREEZER TO USE AT A COOLER TIME.



RECYCLED BIRD FEEDER

IF YOU WANT TO AVOID A STICKY FAT MIXTURE
THEN THIS IS A GREAT IDEA TO RECYCLE USED CARTONS INTO SEED HOLDERS.



WASH AND DRY YOUR USED DRINK CARTON AND DECORATE.

CUT LARGE WINDOWS INTO EACH SIDE, ABOUT HALF-WAY UP.

PIERCE A HOLE AT THE SAME HEIGHT BENEATH OPPOSITE WINDOWS,

THREAD A LONG, THIN TWIG THROUGH THE HOLES TO MAKE PERCHES.

TO HANG PUNCH TWO HOLES THROUGH THE LIP AT THE TOP OF THE CARTON AND THRED THROUGH STRING.

FILL WITH A BIRD SEED MIX AND HANG!








MAKE YOUR OWN EASTER BUNNY EARS
